

Communication Between Parents and Teachers

We firmly believe communication between parents and teachers are essential to the children's optimal development. There are many opportunities for parents to be aware of what is going on in the classroom and their children's lives.

- During pick-up, please allot yourself time for a **face-to-face** conversation with the teachers to talk about your child's day. This is a great opportunity to discuss any challenging behaviors that may have arisen during the day.
- An individual "**daily note**" will be sent every day providing information about your child (how long they napped, reminders, diaper change)
- A **lesson plan** will be posted on the hallway bulletin board providing information about our developmental curriculum for each week.
- Please be sure to read any flyer posted on the front door or letters sent in your child's lunch bag / folder. They will often have important information, i.e. updates with the classroom, classroom parties, pre-conference worksheets, etc.
- Every other month our **express newsletter** will be sent out. Each issue will present updates in our curriculum and classroom routines, and events.
- Two times per year, I will hold a **parent-teacher conference** to discuss with you your child's individual development and goals.
- You are welcome to request a **meeting** anytime during the year to address any concern or to obtain more information regarding the development of your child.
- If you need to reach us, **call** the front office and leave a message, and they will promptly deliver the message to us, and we will return the call as soon as possible.
