Our Class Philosophy

In our classroom, we believe in the respect of every child and teacher. We also respect the family and their individual beliefs and cultures; we will make efforts to assist you in any way possible. Each child will also be provided many different materials and manipulative to foster their cognitive and physical development. We model appropriate behavior that will be encouraged throughout the year. We will provide safety, security, language, communication, emotional regulation, and conflict resolution.

Goals for the Year

Self-Help Skills

Toddlers crave independence and obtain a sense of pride when they begin to accomplish tasks on their own. Throughout the day, they have opportunities to exert their autonomy washing their hands independently and successfully drinking from an open-cup.

Social Competency Skills and Emotional Development

Toddlers are egocentric, and through their everyday interactions with adults and other children, they learn how to express their needs and how to respect and care for others. We don't expect toddlers to grasp the concept of sharing, but we do encourage patience.

Physical Development

Activities to develop large and small muscles are carefully planned. Children can experiment manipulate, discover, progress, and achieve at their own rates.

Cognitive Development

The curriculum is flexible and encourages intellectual growth by developing the thinking process. This is fostered by exposure to and exploration of many materials and games.
